Someone new to Montgomery County may ask, "What's the Ag Reserve and why is it important?" What's your answer?

Some of our schools in the Reserve are overcrowded and I support fully funding these schools.

My regional priorities are to fund the Metro, BRT, the Purple Line, and existing highways, and roads. I do not support M83.

I support an outer beltway, provided it meet environmental criteria and have minimal impact on the Reserve. If an outer beltway cannot meet that criteria, I would not support it.
